Accordingly, it is Conundrum Holdings Pty Ltd policy to:

- Comply with applicable laws and national and industry standards and, where standards do not exist, develop internal rules and standards necessary to protect the environment;
- Ensure that the area disturbed by operations is minimised;
- Conserve any topsoil removed from work areas for later re-use;
- Progressively rehabilitate operations to conform to the site rehabilitation plan;
- Ensure that site indigenous flora and fauna are preserved;
- Implement programs of weed and pest control;
- Minimise off-site discharge by planning and using appropriate technology designed to ensure suppression, collection, and treatment of emissions;
- Manage the collection, storage and use of water efficiently with respect;
- Use explosives in a manner that minimises fly-rock, back break, ground vibration and air blast;
- Consult with those affected by the operations to maintain good community relations;
- Ensure that wastes produced on site are minimised or separated and recycled or disposed of safely.
