Overview of Submissions

Through the everyday running of their quarries, Conundrum always try to buy local. The wider Kerr family embody the spirit required to re-establish Victoria as a manufacturing powerhouse. If Conundrum needs equipment, they will first look local to satisfy their requirement. This community conscious effort creates new skilled local jobs and provides the development of skills locally.

Employment

The North Central Quarry will replace the existing Epping quarry ensuring a continuance of sought after specialised jobs, and the ongoing development of highly specialized jobs in the wider community.

It is clear from the submissions there will be a continuation of the long-held relationships and employment from Epping to Wallan. This will provide stimulating and motivating work to Mitchell Shire locals through both direct and indirect employment opportunities.

Need for Local High-Quality Resources

A significant number of submissions refer to the need for a local high-quality resource to continue their own business. This sentiment is echoed across a range of enterprises from small local business to large infrastructure projects.

"High quality quarry materials are extremely important to the works we deliver and becoming more difficult to source. Our sprayed sealing business carries out works through the Mitchell Shire for the DoT and tenders for Mitchell Shire and surrounding Municipal road resurfacing contracts on an annual basis" - Road Services Supplier

Many within the Conundrum community have indicated they are dependent on the supply of local resource to ensure they remain competitive. The proposed quarry will provide the required high quality and commercial local resources.

Conundrum creates a level of competition countering the monopolistic tendencies of large integrated quarry operations.

"Currently there exists a monopoly for road base materials within the Mitchell Shire which is reflected in the most recent pricing. Mitchell Shire, rate payers and other consumers will ALL benefit from this competition".

"As a premixed concrete supplier, we are often obliged to operate within the boundaries set by the monopoly that already exists outright within the industry; with multinational companies owning and controlling the vast majority of existing quarries. These multinational companies ... dictate supply, pricing, demand and supply among other things. It is of crucial importance that an independent operator such as Conundrum Holdings can counter the monopoly somewhat. Conundrum allows us flexibility, competitiveness and return trade; somewhat refreshing in our current economic environment."


